OVERVIEW AND IMPACT:

The **Festival Special Events Assistant** is responsible for inventory and production supporting the Festival Special Events Coordinator and Special Events Manager in implementing over 50 Festival events. This position focuses specifically on inventory management, product delivery, event load in, load out, overall event production, sponsor and guest interaction, and volunteer management.

PRIMARY DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Organize, maintain, and track product inventory for approximately 50 Festival events
- Correspond with sponsors and suppliers to coordinate delivery of Festival product
- Keep detailed records of supplies used at each event, and remaining in event inventory
- · Manage and Assist with load-in and load-out of events, supervision of event strike
- Scheduling and management of volunteers
- Coordinate and implements product delivery to all Festival events and Hospitality Suite
