

# QUALITY CONTROL MANAGER Job Description

# OVERVIEW AND IMPACT:

Reporting to the Technical Operations Manager and Director of Operations, the **Quality Control Manager** is responsible for managing cinema content and assisting the Technical Operations Manager with projection and technical duties.

# **PRIMARY DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Schedule, operate, configure, and troubleshoot digital cinema projector and server including TMS operation, content and KDM ingestion, basic projector setup; create daily, automated digital cinema playlists each week across multiple venues for general cinema programming
- Work with Union to schedule operators on an as needed basis
- Exhibit alternate content and related equipment including Blu-ray, DVD, HDCAM, BETA, audio and video processors, and computer-based presentation
- Assist with managing inbound, outbound, and inter-theater content trafficking; provide documentation logging all content information in FileMaker database
- Perform occasional 'operator-level' service, cleaning and emergency repairs on digital projectors, servers, and networks. Film print inspecting and exhibiting familiarity, particularly 35mm changeover.
- Provide for special event setups, rentals and operations including wireless and analog microphone, PA, and audio mixer setups; assess program needs and recommend necessary equipment for successful event execution
- Maintain strong and regular communication with Technical Operations Manager and Directors of Operations

# QUALIFICATIONS:

- Possess strong digital cinema operation and management skills and experience, particularly d-cinema servers and DCI-compliant projectors
- Ability to pay close attention to quality and execution of presentation and film exhibition
- Basic to intermediate skills in and understanding of networking configuration with ability to effectively troubleshoot
- Experience operating professional 35mm, 16 mm, video, digital cinema, and other related projection equipment
- Experience/familiarity with methods, materials, and tools used in the minor repair, general maintenance, and adjustment of industry-standard cinema technology
- Self-motivated with excellent attention to detail and technical troubleshooting skills
- Experience with major operating systems, including Windows, Mac OS X, and Linux, and the integrated software as well as specialized applications related to cinema projection
- Ability to work flexible schedule regularly consisting of nights, weekends, and holidays
