

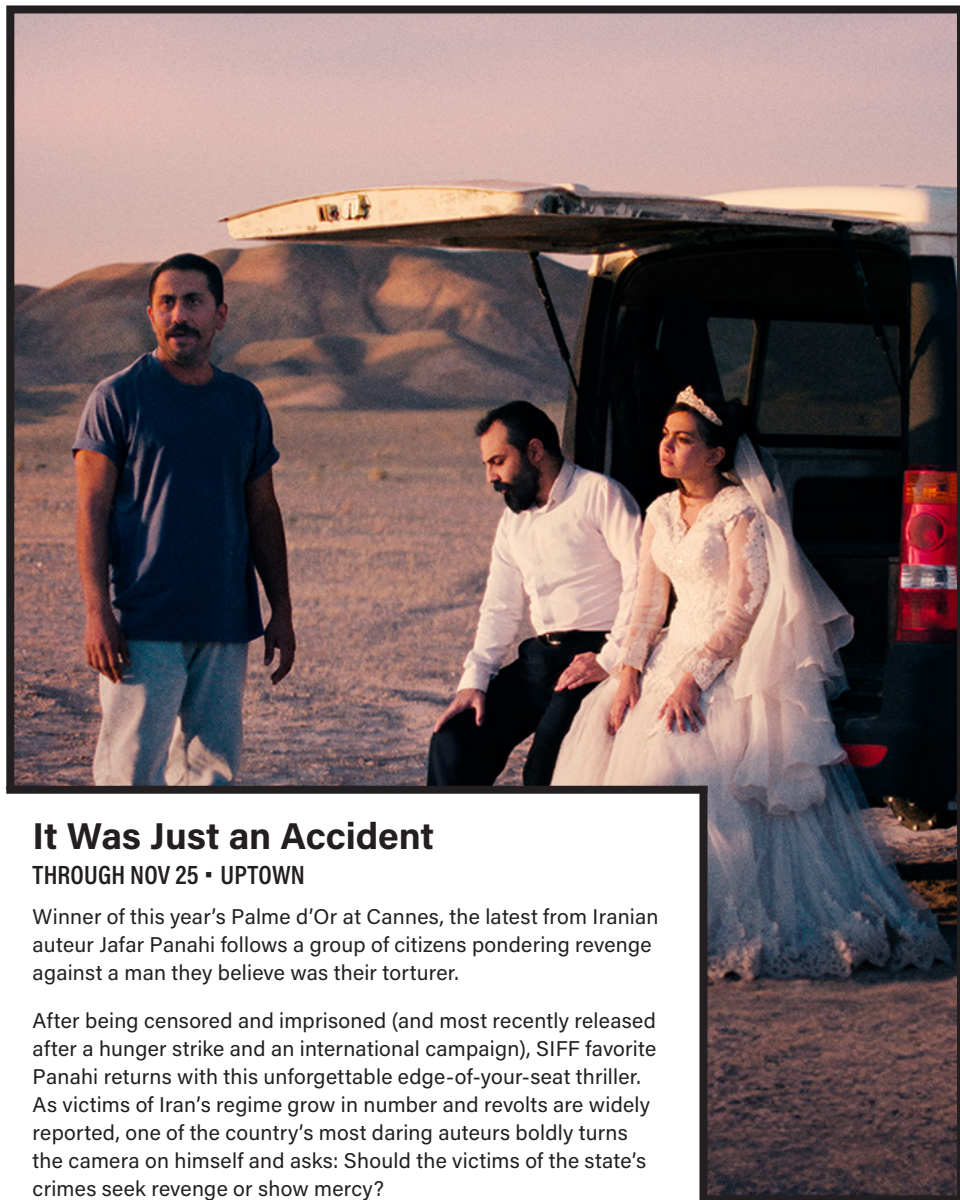

It Was Just an Accident

THROUGH NOV 25 • UPTOWN

Winner of this year's Palme d'Or at Cannes, the latest from Iranian auteur Jafar Panahi follows a group of citizens pondering revenge against a man they believe was their torturer.

After being censored and imprisoned (and most recently released after a hunger strike and an international campaign), SIFF favorite Panahi returns with this unforgettable edge-of-your-seat thriller. As victims of Iran's regime grow in number and revolts are widely reported, one of the country's most daring auteurs boldly turns the camera on himself and asks: Should the victims of the state's crimes seek revenge or show mercy?

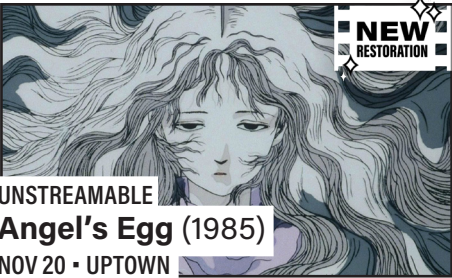
Bugonia

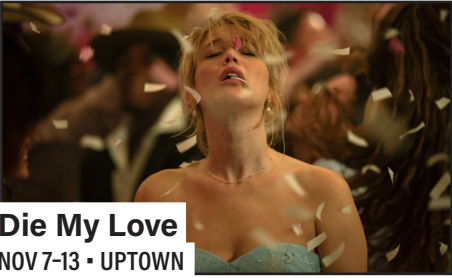

In this Sundance-winning, Portland-set dark comedy, two men trauma-bond at a support group for people who have lost their twin.



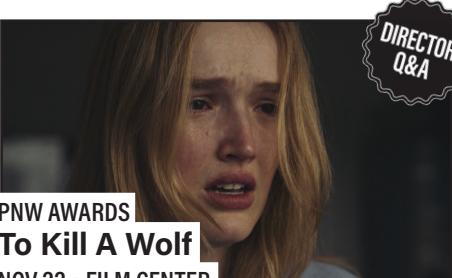
Skweezy Gibbs Makes a Movie

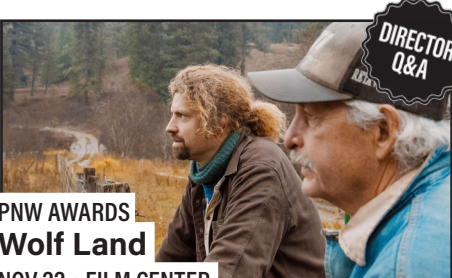
Die My Love

Jennifer Lawrence and Robert Pattinson excel in Lynne Ramsay's bold and brave film about a woman experiencing postpartum psychosis.



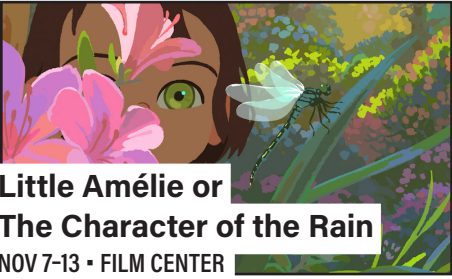

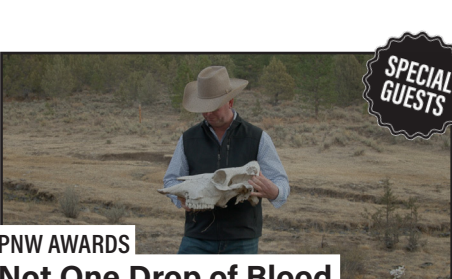
Little Amélie or The Character of the Rain

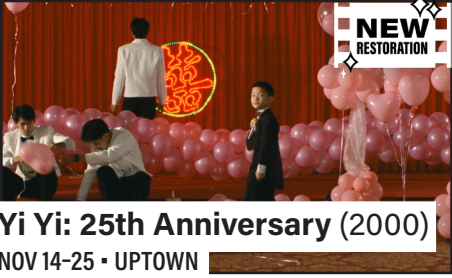
Twin Peaks: The Return (Parts 7 & 8)
