Her daughter is suffering from an unknown disease, and her absent husband is both physically and emotionally not available. When a hole in the ceiling bursts, a metaphor for the immense strain she's under, things start to unravel. The repairs send Linda and her daughter to a motel where a calm, supportive superintendent (an incredible A\$AP Rocky) offers space to breathe. But Linda's mental health continues to spiral, the stresses of her life accumulating.

Jessica Parks is a smart Crown Court Judge at the top of her career. Behind the robe, she is a karaoke fiend, a loving wife and a supportive parent. When an event threatens to throw her life completely off balance, can she hold her family upright?



A proper kick-off, Dr. (of music and theology) Phibes mimics the G'tach—the ten lethal plagues of Egypt—with intentions of vengeance against the doctors and nurses responsible for a botched operation that resulted in the death of his wife. Introduced by Scarecrow Video's Jonathan Marlow.






Valerie and Her Week of Wonders (1974)
